Here are the answers.

Did you always spot which black piece was saying "Check!"

And did you always remember to look out for **C**apturing or **B**locking as well as moving the king **A**way?

The diagrams illustrate the following solutions:

- 1:** King moves from e1 to f2. Check from rook on e8.
- 2:** King moves from e1 to d2. Check from rook on e8.
- 3:** King moves from e1 to f2. Check from rook on e8.
- 4:** King moves from e1 to f2. Check from rook on e8.
- 5:** King moves from e1 to f2. Check from knight on d6.
- 6:** King moves from e1 to f2. Check from knight on d6.
- 7:** King moves from e1 to f2. Check from rook on e8.
- 8:** King moves from e1 to f2. Check from rook on e8.
- 9:** King moves from e1 to f2. Check from rook on e8.
- 10:** King moves from e1 to d2. Check from knight on d6.
